

EARLY LEVEL BAROQUE & CLASSICS FESTIVAL

Synopsis: The Early Level Baroque and Classics Festival (ELBCF) provides an encouraging performance



experience of 18th and early 19th Century music for students at the *Preparatory through Fifth Level* of study. It further promotes the appreciation and understanding of these two important classical styles through an evaluation by a qualified judge.

- Who may enter: Preparatory through level five.
- **Deadline to apply:** Midnight Sunday evening, two weeks prior to the event.
- Fee: \$11.00 per performer.
- Date and Time: Sunday, February 12, 2:00 p.m. Exact time may vary.
- Location: Holy Trinity Lutheran Church.

Repertoire Requirements:

- 1. **Time Limit:** Three minutes. A student may play more than one piece by either the same or a different composer as long as the combined time does not exceed 3 minutes.
- 2. **Music Allowed:** Preparatory thru Five (5). Music written between 1600 through ca. 1830, Teachers may consult the CM syllabus for guidance., Contact the chairperson with questions regarding repertoire selections.
- 3. **Memorization:** Pianists may not use music during performance. Other disciplines may use music as is customary to their discipline.

Dress and Decorum: It is requested that students show respect for this event through their dress. It is recommended they dress as follows:

- 1. **Boys:** slacks with belt and tucked in buttoned shirt with collar with dress shoes. Jacket and tie are desirable.
- 2. Girls: dress or a skirt and blouse and dressy shoes.

Shorts, t-shirts, blue-jeans and white or colored sneakers are not allowed (exception: black sneakers).

Special Instructions: Students are to number the first measure of each line of their music and bring it to the performance for the judges use. Students are to arrive no less than fifteen minutes prior to his or her group's start time.



Instructions for Teachers to make Schedule Preference selections (Carpool, AM/PM, Location, Date) on each student's Application Details screen. The Schedule Preference Ribbon is the 5th Ribbon on the Application Details screen – below Repertoire List.

- 1. Teacher's login to <u>new.mtac.org</u>
- 2. Click CM block (or click Programs and select CM from dropdown menu).
- 3. Click Student List ribbon.

4. Click the colored block in the Branch/Regional Panel column to open a student's 2017 Application Details screen.

5. Scroll down the screen and click the **Schedule Preferences** gold ribbon to request preferences for the student (it's below the Repertoire List ribbon).

- 6. You will only see the preference options that your branch has allowed.
- 7. Click on each box to view and select choices.

8. Carpool requests: **Enter Application ID# (not Student ID#)** and last name of the <u>other</u> carpool member in the first carpool box and enter last name. Enter App ID# and last name of any additional carpool members. Click "Save Schedule Preferences". The system will automatically complete the rest of the boxes information. (The easiest place to find the ID is on your Student List, the column title says Student ID but it is the Application ID).

Note: From the CM screen, open Resources ribbon and on the left, you will see a link for Instructions to Enter Repertoire. That document can help you get to the Application Details screen, as well.

PRINT OUT YOUR STUDENT LIST. Check that all students were successfully registered. If any of your students' names do not appear on this list, their registrations are not complete.


Delete all students who are not participating this year.


