

1. Each teacher will be asked to pay a \$10 teacher fee the first time she accesses the <u>scibf.org</u> student registration system. This \$10 fee will cover all students of that teacher. This money will be used to defray costs for programming, website hosting and software upgrades required for the maintenance of the <u>scibf.org</u> website. The teacher fee for CWA is being eliminated.

2. Judges will be asked to select 50% of students playing eligible repertoire to advance to the regional festival, **under the condition that the student has a cumulative score of at least 270.** (270 represents an average of 90 from each judge.) Please begin to publicize this at all of your branch events.

Branch rules:

1) No Anna Magdalena pieces.

- 2) Requests are limited to AM or PM only with valid reasons.
- 3) Students who fail to attend their assigned recitals are subject to disqualification.
- 4) Teachers who enter students are expected to work on the festival day. If you cannot work on the festival day, you will need to send in a substitute.

#### Reminders:

- PRINT OUT YOUR STUDENT LIST. If any of your students' names do not appear on this list, their registrations are not complete.
- Delete all students who are not participating this year.
- The Regional Festival is on May 11, 2019. Each performer will pay \$12 to cover the cost of regional registration.




