## MTAC-Conejo Valley Branch Festimantic! The YouTube Romantic Festival 2016 Guidelines

Important information: **\$24** Entry Fee due to Nina Kelly, Postmarked Jan. 19, 2016 Deadline for Uploaded video to YouTube: **January 19th, 2016** Honors Recitals: Holy Trinity Lutheran Church. **February 6th, 2016 (10:30-6:00)** 

#### Details:

Here are the procedures for the 2016 YouTube Festimantic! Your students can record and quickly upload their Romantic style pieces to participate in the 2016 YouTube Festimantic! sponsored by the MTAC-Conejo Valley Branch.

Eligible repertoire: Romantic and Impressionistic Style Music Piano and other instruments: Level 5 and up. Voice: Level 3 and up.

In order to participate in the festival, you or your students will have to have the ability to upload their videos onto YouTube. On the <u>www.youtube.com</u> page, there is a link to "create and account," or "upload." Anybody who is going to participate will have to go to this page and do what is necessary for posting a video. Simply click onto the link and follow the directions. It should be quite simple.

There are instructions on the YouTube website to help you if you need it.

There are many ways to do this and it would be pretty unusual to have a student or parent who cannot do this. If they cannot upload videos, they will not be able to participate in this program.

All students have to record their piece, then will need to upload their own videos. There are several security features that can be chosen. One can choose to keep the video very secure and to limit the amount of views. Please leave enough freedom to allow our three judges to watch the video as well as your teacher. Once the URL link has been established by YouTube, please send the link to **their teachers**, who will forward them to Nina Kelly: <u>emmajen@roadrunner.com</u>

Once the video is uploaded, it will be given a URL address. Use the URL to watch the video you uploaded to be sure it plays correctly. (YouTube will automatically assign your video a URL address.) Once you have that address (which will be unique), you should send that address to your TEACHER, to verify its quality.

The <u>TEACHER</u> then sends the URL to Nina Kelly who will keep an order of the URL addresses sent to her.

Please do NOT have students email the link to the chairperson.

Along with the video's URL address, please include in the email:

Student's full name,

Teacher's name,

The Name of the Repertoire on the video.

The accurate Timing of piece included as well.

All of this must be in the same email and please, teachers, send all your students' URL & information in one email, rather than one email at a time! Wait until you have all your students' information, then send it, no later than the deadline date: Jan. 19.

TEACHERS are to write <u>ONE</u> check to MTAC, just like we do for CM, & send/deliver it to Nina Kelly (add your address) Thousand Oaks, CA 91360

No checks from parents will be accepted.

Since each video will have its own URL, there is no need to have any identifying sign or speaking on the video. The judges will receive a numbered list with the URL addresses and the name of the pieces being performed. We will retain the name of the student and teacher. We will ask the judges to rate the performances and give a numerical score. Once they have fully completed their task, we will collect the scores and a committee will put together the honors festival, in the same fashion that we do with the Contemporary Music Festival.

Rules of video taping:

Eligible repertoire: Romantic and Impressionistic Style Music Piano and other instruments: Level 5 and up Voice: Level 3 and up.



When making the video, students are to be videotaped using a single camera, at an angle that shows the instrument, face and hands clearly.

The camera should be stationary, on a tripod, or steady surface, not hand-held or moved around. No editing is allowed.

A clear view of the student's profile or front view (if an instrumentalist or vocalist) and their hands, this way immediate identification can take place if there is a question of matching the video to the student. All memorization rules for the Contemporary Music Festival apply here as well.

In the past, YouTube had a maximum duration for videos, but this has changed. Your entire piece should be recorded and uploaded without difficulty.

If the student is playing a piece with multiple sections, a 4-minute time limit is the rule.

A single movement or a single work that exceeds the 4-minute time limit is allowed.

These are the same rules as with the Contemporary Festival.

All instruments and voice are eligible.

The timetable is listed below:

• Videos posted onto YouTube by Jan. 19

• Application fees to Nina Kelly due Jan. 20 (if checks are not received or postmarked by this date, URL addresses of that teacher's students will be removed from consideration.)

The fee is \$24 per student-payable MTAC-Conejo Valley. (from the teacher...

participants will reimburse the fee to their teachers)

- We hope to announce the Honors Recital participants within two weeks of this due date.
- Festimantic! Honors Recital will be on at Holy Trinity Lutheran Church.

THERE ARE NO REFUNDS ONCE THE REGISTRATION DEADLINE PASSES AND FEES ARE PAID.
