#### \*\*NEW FOR 2015/16 "BRANCH ONLY" EVENTS\*\*

- A new "Branch Only Competition" which does not advance to the State level
- Each instrument competes separately instead of all strings and all winds
- Voice categories offer the option of classical or musical theater/pop
- Ensemble category will allow for piano 4 hands
- VOCE Instrument Masterclasses when 4 or more students of the same instrument express willingness to participate
- Only ONE solo piece is required with no level requirement
- Fintry Due Date: December 15th, 2015
- Payment Deadline: Jan. 10th, 2016

Please note the earlier deadline of December 15th. You will receive a link via email in November.

The Conejo Valley will have 2 VOCE programs running concurrently on the same day: one that is only for branch members and does not go further than our area, the second is the traditional VOCE program with a State level competition. Our branch level competition will have an online application that will be sent to the chair, Wendy Velasco. The State level competition will be filled out completely online. All payments and proof of age will be coordinated through the State Website. Below are the instructions for this process. IT IS NOT THE SAME AS PREVIOUS YEARS SO PLEASE READ CAREFULLY.

The VOCE Program has migrated to the new online web system. You will need to log in to **new.mtac.org**. Use your existing username and password. When you log in for the first time, you will need to change your password. Follow the instructions on the screen to change the password.

Once logged in, you will be presented with a list of students that were migrated from the old database. Only those students who participated in VOCE last year are listed. You will need to confirm these students so that they can be migrated and added to your roster.

You will receive documents via email with the Branch-Only Rules and Guidelines in early November. The State program rules and guidelines can be found on the State website. You do not need to collect payment or proof of age from your students. The new website will contact the families directly so be sure to have a current email address for your students when you log on. If you are planning to enroll students in this program, please send me an email at CelloVelasco@gmail.com and I will send you some additional instructions which will hopefully make the process a little easier.

If you are enrolling in the Branch-Only events, the application will be done via google docs. I will send a link. Please do not fill out the form directly on the email. Instead, click on the link to complete the form. After you have sent in the form, the payment will be due by January 10th. Please pay with one check per teacher. Make the check payable to MTAC Conejo-Valley and mail to
